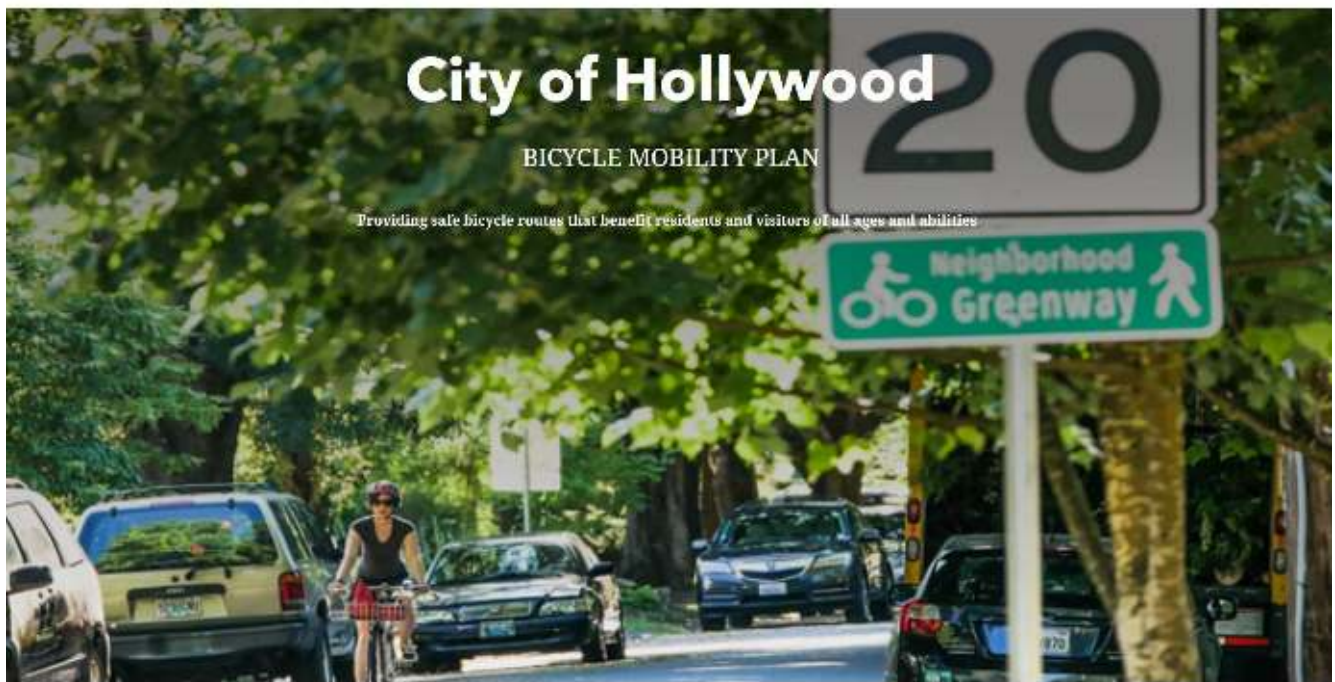


Where is the Transit Oriented Corridor located?

The Transit Oriented Corridor in Hollywood is generally located East of the Florida Turnpike and West of 58th Avenue.

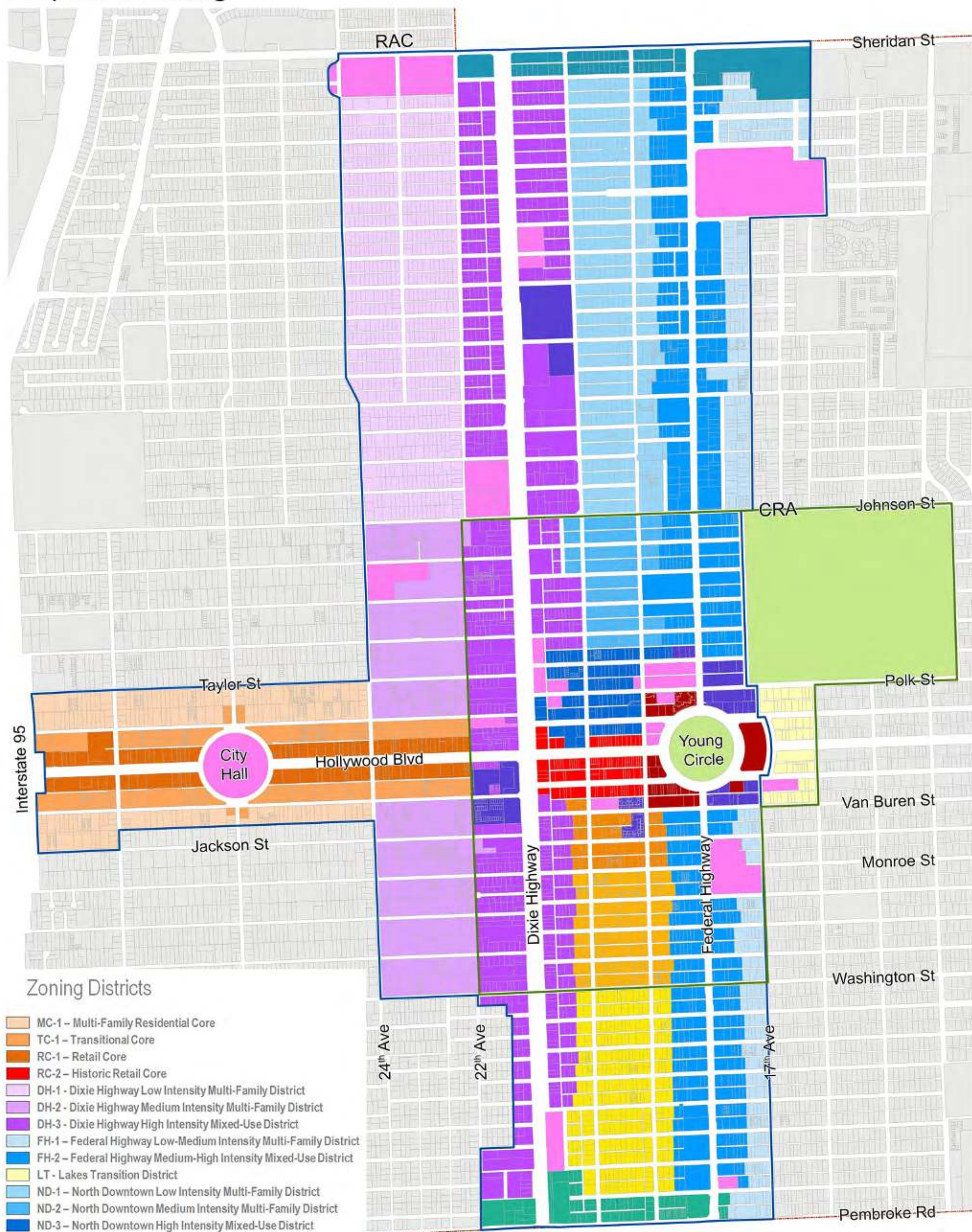

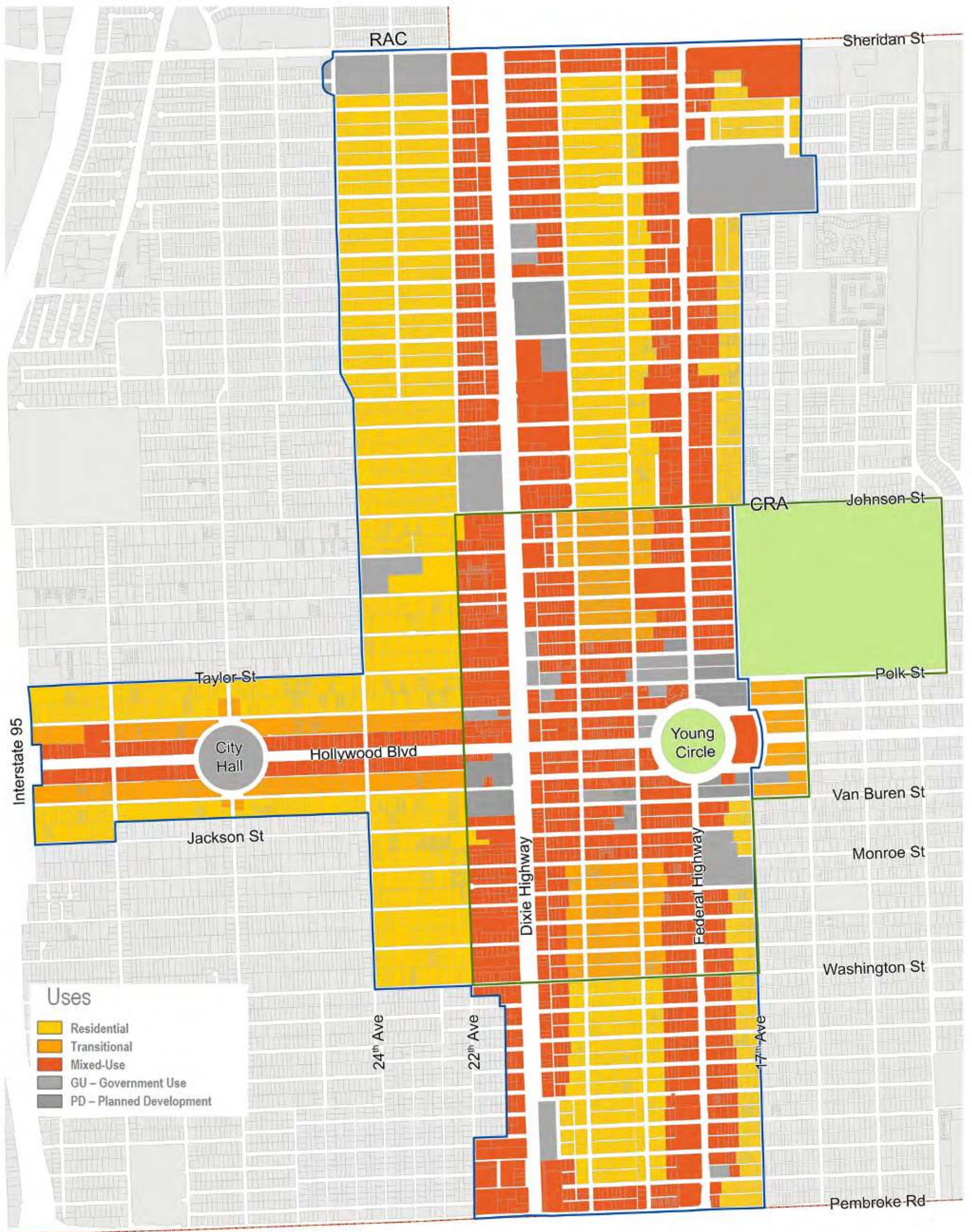

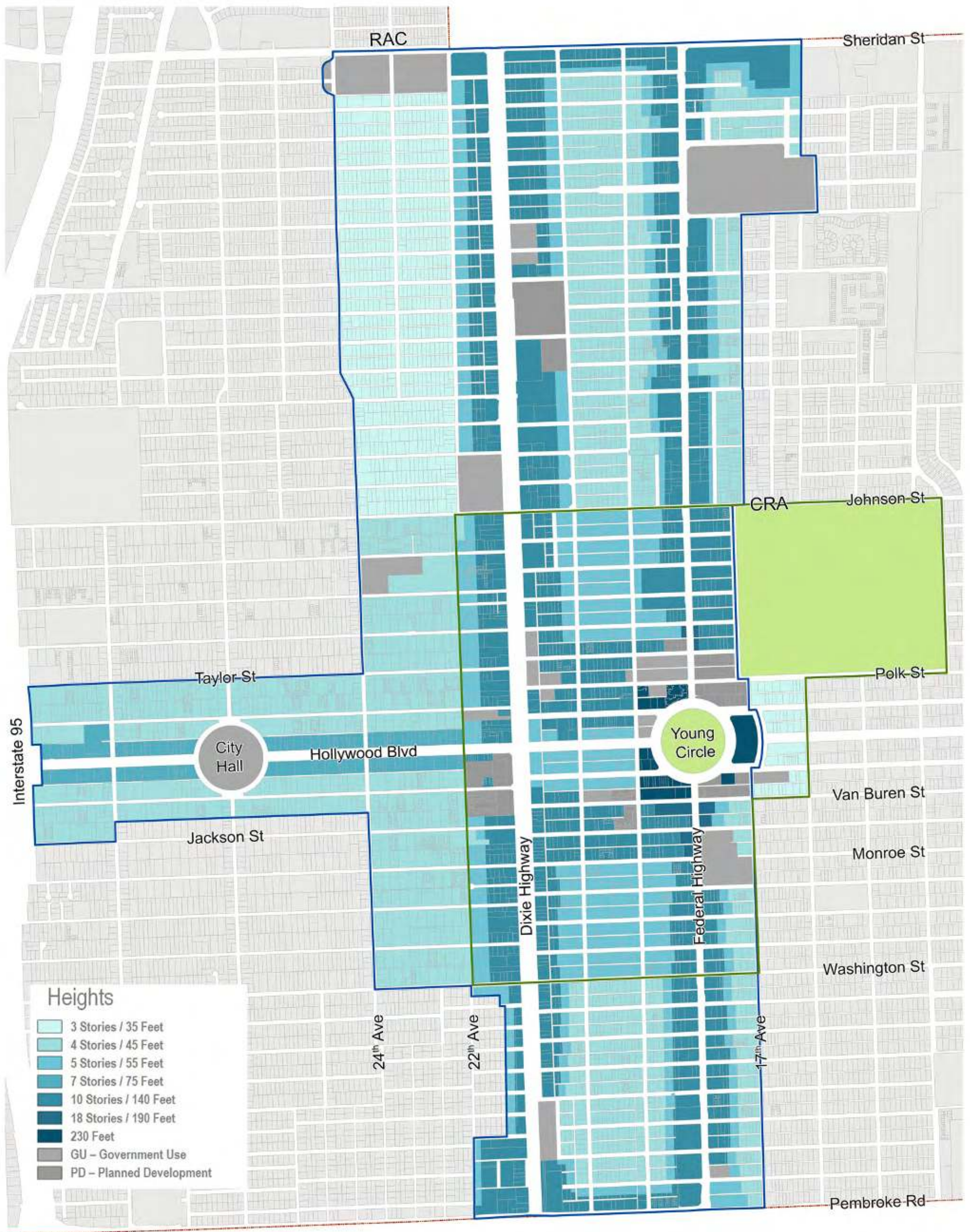
RAC Rezoning Proposed Typologies

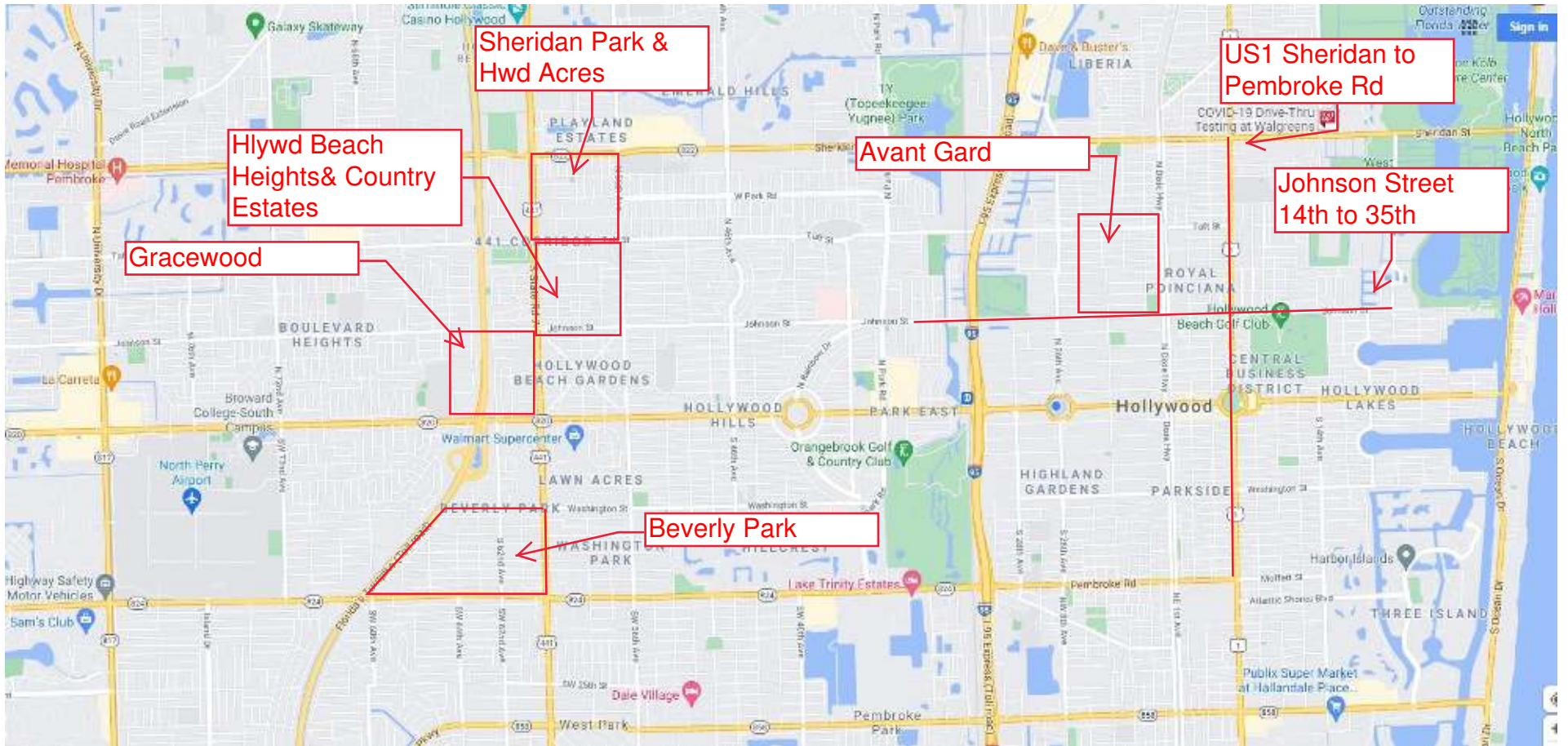
RAC Rezoning Proposed Heights
